University of York Apprenticeship Course Update(Martin Weber)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This will progress at University of York • Bespoke blended offer with in person learning current cohorts, online and distance learning. • Utilise existing provision of the campus. Aim for these students to feel part of a wider group and can join in with the student experience. • Apprenticeship model to be drafted for consultation • Difficulty committing numbers without a model in place but all LAs are interested would like to see model and end point assessment structure. • Timeline with SWE approval is now for start September 2024. • Meeting to be scheduled for May to discuss model further. <p>4. Future of the Teaching Partnership</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current funding goes to 31 March 2023. PM role goes to November 2023. Still money remaining from previous years underspend. • What do we want to see if we secure further funding? Ideas from partners to be sent to JK • Will need to see what comes out of the Care Review due out next week. Hints have been made that CPD, ASYE, 3 year practice framework will feature. From another meeting a project to look at career progression had been mentioned along with apprenticeships. • Meeting to be scheduled in next few weeks to go through the document. Partners to put forward strategic names. • What happens if there is no funding? Based on timelines for PM role decisions need to be made July time. • Contributions of £15k were mentioned for PM and/Admin roles but no point having these roles if there is no funding.
